





Berewood Primary School is an Academy sponsored by the University of Chichester (Multi) Academy Trust. The constitution of the Local Governing Body is identified within the Scheme of Delegation and includes staff and parent governors, who are elected to their positions with a four year term of office, members appointed by the Directors of the Trust or Governing Body, also with a four year term of office, co-opted members appointed by the Directors of the Trust with a term of office of one year and the head teacher who is an ex-officio member.

	<p><b>Mrs Charlotte Corp</b> (Community Governor and Chair of Governors) Appointed by Trust Directors / LGB 17.03.2021 – 17.03.2029</p> <p>Charlotte (Charlie) has a daughter in Year 6 and has a son in Year 4. She joined the governing body in early 2021. Charlie has been a teacher for over 20 years, in local secondary schools (teaching many of Berewood's parents).
